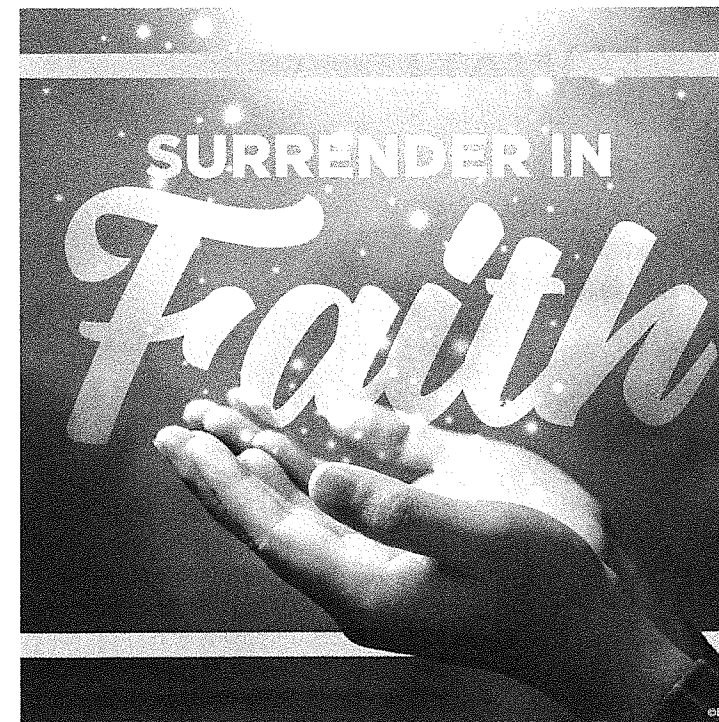
The Sunday Evening Mass time will be moved to 5 pm beginning August 1, 2021.
