
Many people give their allegiance to something until it asks them to do something challenging or radical. Then, they find themselves rethinking whether they want to be associated with it. The same holds for God. Either we serve God, or we don't. There can be no lukewarm stance with regard to faith. If we are in, then faith in Jesus Christ asks us to do some difficult things: work in the service of God's kingdom, love our enemies, turn the other cheek, and trust that the Eucharist is in fact Jesus' very Body and Blood.
